

Duration of Visit

The duration of the visit is 1.5 hours including a free guided tour and interactive workshop (Subject to availability)



Group Size & Concurrent Visits

Each group can include 20 students, with a maximum of 25. Schools may bring up to three groups per day, with a 1.5-hour interval between each visit

GUIDED TOURS

Our guided tours are led by knowledgeable team members who bring each exhibition to life through storytelling, dialogue, and engaging discussion. Tailored to different age groups and learning levels, these tours offer visitors a deeper understanding of the artworks, artists, and themes on display.
