This exhibition highlights the Villain Collection, bringing together modern and contemporary voices from across the Arab world.




Home Is Not a Place

Age Recommendations

We welcome students aged 6 and above to experience the world of art.



Duration of Visit

The duration of the visit is 1.5 hours including a free guided tour and interactive workshop (**Subject to availability**)



Group Size & Concurrent Visits

Schools may book one group visit per day, with a maximum of **20** students in each group.
